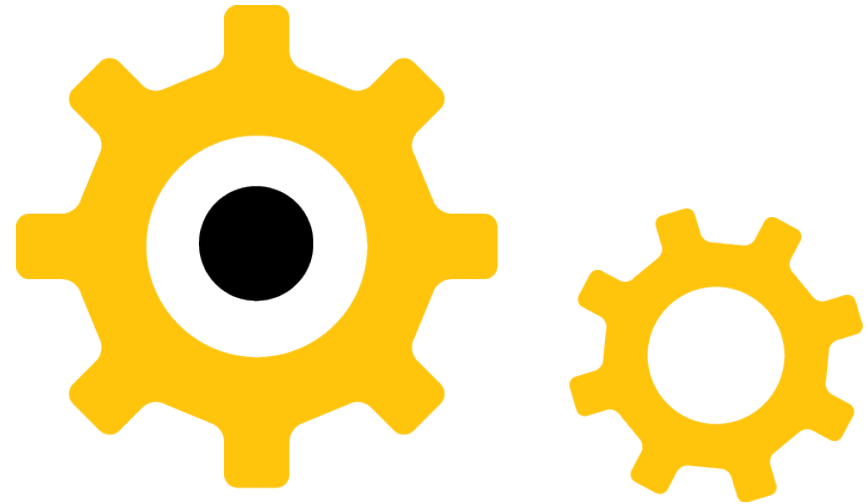

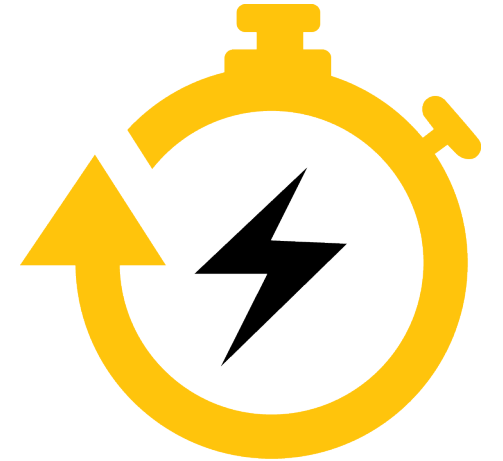

Benefits of data feeds

- Automated transaction processing
- Balance reconciliation
- Daily updating of market prices and income
- Mitigates human error



Different types of data feeds

Data feeds with no authority process

Class maintains multiple sources of data feeds that are made available to all businesses.

- Daily pricing for ASX, foreign markets and managed funds under APIR code
- Exchange rate for major foreign currencies
- Income announcements

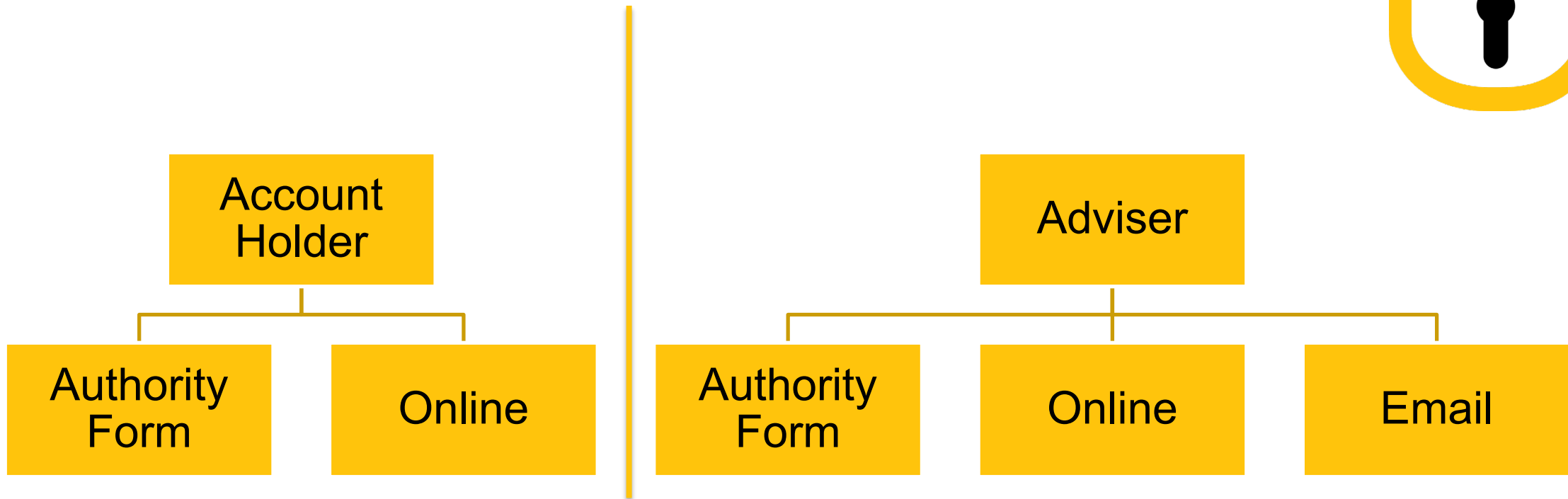
Different types of data feeds

Data feeds with authority process

- Bank accounts
- Platform and Wrap accounts
- Stockbroking accounts



Authorisation types



Feeds set up process – Account holder


Once the configuration information (account details) have been entered:

1. Generate the authority form
2. Review the form and fill in any required information
3. Request the account holder to sign the form
4. Upload the authority form to Class
5. Send the form to the relevant financial institution / feed provider (if applicable)
6. Change the status in the feed set up in Class to 'Waiting on Provider'

Feed set up process – Adviser

The adviser role needs to be set up for the adviser before setting up the feed process.

Business level:

1. Contacts > +New > New Person (can also be an existing contact)
2. Add information in 'Details' tab > Save
3. Go to 'Roles' tab > + Add Role > Adviser
4. Go to 'Authorities' tab > search for product in 'Add Authority' box
5. Add the adviser code (and credentials) > Save
6. If validation is required, click on  > Validate Authority


Feed set up process – Adviser

Once the configuration information has been entered:

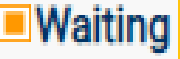
1. Select the adviser from the drop down menu
2. Link any cash accounts and investment accounts that exist in Class
3. Request the Adviser to activate the feed:
 - Authority form
 - Email
 - Online
4. Change the status to 'Waiting on Provider'

Management of data feeds


- Business level Feeds Console
- Status on Feeds Console

**Setup**

- Waiting on verification
- Rejected by provider
- Unlinked accounts


**Waiting**

- Waiting on Provider
- Waiting on Authoriser
- Activation Overdue
- Follow-up Requested

**Error**

- Unbalanced
- Feed no longer active

- Configuration and authority process:
 - 'Help on this automated feed' link will redirect to the relevant user guide (see Note)
- Follow-up process
 - Click on  to follow up with the provider or Class.
